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QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Questions and answers apply to request for clarifications in regard to RFQ UNOPS-SFRS-2015-G-020 for purchase of timber wall bars and protective net for two schools and health centre in Obrenovac.

- Q:** Within "Comparative data form", under Item 1, Timber wall bars, it says that wall bars need to be "mounted on the wall on static metal bracket without fixing on the floor". You have also added drawing of the timber wall bars, but we are not able to see where the metal bracket is supposed to be mounted. Could you please clarify in what area (portion) of the timber wall bars metal brackets need to be mounted- upper, middle or lower!

A: Timber wall bars have to be mounted on a metal substructure in a manner that will ensure stability and security during the utilization in accordance with regular purpose. During installation and subsequent using of products, the floor must not be damaged.

- Q:** Within "Comparative data form", under Item 1, Timber wall bars, the requirement is for timber wall bars to be made of "sides: dry wood "ČPČ" class without knots with elliptical or round crossbar, made of quality ash wood...". In order to help you better evaluate and make right decision regarding the quality of the offered product we think it's necessary for potential bidders to supply sample of the timber wall bar that's being offered. Is it necessary to supply sample of the offered timber wall bar in order to prove that offered product fulfils required quality specifications requested within tender description!?

A: Bidders may submit samples of the timber wall bar, but it is not obligatory.
